Directions

Carpet Cleaners: Mix ½ ounce per gallon of carpet cleaning solution.

Cigarette Urns: Mix 2-4 ounces per gallon of water. Allow urns to air dry before reuse.

Normal Deodorizing: Mix ½ ounce per gallon of water. Apply with pump-up or trigger sprayer.

Fogging: For light odor problems, use 1 part to 3 parts water.

For more severe odors (heavy fire damage or urine), use 1 part to 1 part water. Close up area for 12 hours, then ventilate thoroughly.

Garbage Containers, Compactors And Dumpsters: Use 12 ounces per gallon of water. Spray daily to suppress objectionable odors.

Hand Spraying: Mix 4-6 ounces per gallon of water.

Hospitals: Use on bedpans, in restrooms, offices, diaper and bandage collection containers, garbage compactors, etc., as indicated in specific areas.

Hotels/Motels: Use in guest rooms, kitchens, restrooms, or offices as indicated in specific areas.

Kennels: Remove animals from area. Mix 2-4 ounces per gallon of water. Mop or spray surfaces to be cleaned. Allow to air dry before returning animals.

Light Cleaning: Mix 1-2 ounces per gallon of water. Spray on surface; wipe dry with sponge, cloth, or paper towel.

Restrooms: Mix 4-6 ounces per gallon of water in hand sprayer. Spray toilet bowls, seats, urinals, lavatories, tubs, and showers.

Rinse Water: Mix ½ ounce per gallon of water.

Schools: Use in classrooms, restrooms, locker rooms, or offices as indicated in specific areas.

NOTICE: Do not mix with disinfectant/cleaners or sanitizers. Do not use on oriental rugs or water-sensitive upholstery.
